Samarapan – School of Fine Arts was found by Bhavini Subramani.

Bhavini Subramani started her BharataNatyam and music education in Kalakshetra - Chennai in 1980 and then graduated from Shri Satguru Sangeeta Samajam in Madurai. She also did part of her basic education in Kalakshetra School.

After moving to Delhi, she learned from Padmashri Leela Samson – and honed her skills in the Kalakshetra style of dance. In addition to BharataNatyam, Bhavini has also learned Mohiniattam and Kuchipudi. She has performed in various locations in India and has been part of many productions of Leela Samson as her senior dancer. She has taught in Delhi and Madurai at prestigious institutes, and choreographed many productions. She has continued her formal association with Great institutes by being part of the Kalakshiti Institute under Prof. M.R.Krishnamurthy (ex. Kalakshetra) both as a senior student, performer and a teacher whenever she is in India.

Her thirst for this art-form beckoned her back to dancing while she was in the USA. She continued her involvement to promote the art form through various channels. Her passion for BharataNatyam took her to back to India to work with renowned Bharatanatyam gurus like Prof. M.R Krishnamurthy, Prof. Janaradhanan, and Smt. Ambika Buch of Kalakshetra.

She performed at the centenary celebration in memory of Smt. Rukmani Devi Arundale of Kalakshetra. She has performed solo and part of a group in the various places in US and India. Her production “Samarpanam – A Dedication to Gurus” was performed by her students as a charity event. She was the main Bharatanatyam coordinator and choreographer in the “Shivoham Shivoham” production for Hindu Temple of Atlanta. Her involvement in performing for private and public charity event is her way of sharing the talent for a noble cause. She recently directed and choreographed Ramayana – a dance drama as fund raiser for Hindu Temple of Atlanta.

Bhavini Subramani is a versatile individual – with proven leadership skills both in corporate management and community service. She has strong organizational skills which have helped her successfully spearhead the cultural events of Festival of India, GATS programs, and other cultural programs in Georgia. She is well known to the Indian cultural community of Atlanta, as performer or organizer.
